Angliss Neighbourhood House courses are for people who are keen to improve their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. We offer people the chance to learn and practice their English skills in a comfortable, informal and relaxed atmosphere at a low cost. Students will have the opportunity to improve their reading and writing skills for day to day life, for employment or for further study. New students can enter the class at any time (if there is a place available).

As a small, friendly and accessible neighbourhood house we are well placed to support your individual learning needs and to assist you in achieving the best possible learning outcomes. The administration and teaching staff will make every effort to provide you with relevant information about course selection and ongoing training options.

The houses provides support, skill development and social activities. We deliver quality adult education programs that reflect the interests and needs of all sectors of our community.

Classes run all year round on a school term basis and if you would like to enrol in an accredited class you will need to make an appointment for an interview. All new students need to be interviewed to ensure they are placed in a suitable class. The interview will be to determine your eligibility and enrolment at your certificate level. In 2020 accredited courses offered are 22484VIC Certificate I in EAL Framework (Access) and 22485VIC Certificate II in EAL Framework Access). If you are eligible, tuition is \$25 per term concession and fee exemption is available for students facing financial hardship.

*Concession prices only apply to self-funded individuals. Organisations providing funding (even indirectly) are not eligible for concession rates. A statement of fees is available on our website [ww.anglissnh.net.au](http://ww.anglissnh.net.au)*
